Plants Tolerant of Moist Soils

These plants will tolerate soils that are continuously moist or are subject to occasional flooding where the water usually recedes in 2-3 days. When planting, dig the hole three times the width of the rootball and 75% as deep.

Plants Tolerant of Heavy Clay Soils

These plants will tolerate heavy clay soils, even if it drains slowly. If the plant is also listed under Plants Tolerant of Moist Soils then it will tolerate standing water. In poorly drained, or hard compacted soils, dig the hole three times the width of the rootball and 75% as deep.
